Western Carolina Presents Winners of the 6th Annual Freshwater Freddie Golf Tournament and United Way Fundraiser

Western Carolina Regional Sewer Authority recently hosted the 6th Annual Freshwater Freddie Golf Tournament at the Southern Oaks Golf Course in Easley. Over 96 participants competed in this tournament to raise \$4,182 for the United Way.
