**Western Carolina Presents 2nd Place Winners of the 7th Annual Freshwater Freddie Golf Tournament and United Way Fundraiser**

Greenville, S.C. (July 9, 2007) - Western Carolina Regional Sewer Authority recently hosted the 7th Annual Freshwater Freddie Golf Tournament at the Southern Oaks Golf Course in Easley. Over 100 participants competed in this tournament to raise \$4,919 for the United Way. The second place team, which included Buster Nix from Western Carolina's Collection System Department and his teammates Harold Champion, Michael Jordan and Shane Holcombe, was presented with the Freshwater Freddie 7th Annual Golf Tournament 2nd place plaque. Prizes, donated by local companies and several individuals throughout the community, were also given away to the participants of the tournament.

The Freshwater Freddie Golf Tournament was named after the Western Carolina mascot, who was introduced to the Greenville area in 2001 during the "Name That Frog" contest. A first grade class from Hollis Academy submitted the winning entry of "Freshwater Freddie". Western Carolina adopted a frog as its public education mascot to emphasize the importance of protecting Greenville's freshwater resources.
