Western Carolina Presents 2nd Place Winners of the 6th Annual Freshwater Freddie Golf Tournament and United Way Fundraiser

Western Carolina Regional Sewer Authority recently hosted the 6th Annual Freshwater Freddie Golf Tournament at the Southern Oaks Golf Course in Easley. Over 96 participants competed in this tournament to raise \$4,182 for the United Way. The second place team, which included Buster Nix from Western Carolina's Collection System Department and his teammates Shane Holcombe of Brady Construction, Zach Martin of Sherwin-Williams, and Drew Penley who is a full-time student at Clemson University, was presented with the Freshwater Freddie 6th Annual Golf Tournament 2nd place plaque. The Freshwater Freddie Golf Tournament was named after the Western Carolina mascot, who was introduced to the Greenville area in 2001 during the "Name That Frog" contest.
