Western Carolina Presents Winners of the 8th Annual Freshwater Freddie Golf Tournament and United Way Fundraiser

Greenville, S.C. (June 11, 2008)- Western Carolina Regional Sewer Authority recently hosted the 8th Annual Freshwater Freddie Golf Tournament at the Southern Oaks Golf Course in Easley. More than 100 participants competed in this tournament to raise \$5,614 for the United Way. The first place team, which included David Roberts, Charlie Campbell, Mike Nelson and Bill Rabon, was presented with the Freshwater Freddie 8th Annual Golf Tournament plaque. Prizes, donated by local companies and several individuals throughout the Greenville community, were also given to the participants of the tournament.

The Freshwater Freddie Golf Tournament was named after the Western Carolina mascot, who was introduced to the Greenville area in 2001 during the "Name That Frog" contest. A first grade class from Hollis Academy submitted the winning entry of "Freshwater Freddie".
