Renewable Water Resources Hosts Tour for Schneider Electric

Greenville, S.C. (October 19, 2009) – Renewable Water Resources (ReWa) recently held a tour for a group of fifteen engineers from Schneider Electric Water/Wastewater Competency Center located in Seneca, S.C.



The group designs and develops the electrical process systems for wastewater plants like ReWa's. During the tour, the engineers were able to see the distribution center in action first-hand at ReWa's Pelham treatment plant. Perry Ashmore, Plant Operator, hosted the tour and provided a general overview of the processes onsite.

ReWa regularly hosts facility tours for local schools, colleges/universities, businesses, home schoolers, organizations, Girl and Boy Scout Troops, industries and environmental interest groups as part of its public education program. Other groups and individuals are also welcome. The program is an ongoing effort to increase awareness about the importance of the wastewater treatment process and protecting the aquatic environment of the Upstate. Tour topics are tailored to meet the type of study or interests of the group or individuals touring the facilities.
