Renewable Water Resources Exceeds United Way Fundraising Goal

Greenville, S.C. (September 12, 2011) – Renewable Water Resources (ReWa) have just announced results from an incredible year of fundraising for the United Way of Greenville County. ReWa has raised \$94,423.41, exceeding their original goal of \$92,000.

A portion of those funds came from ReWa's annual Freshwater Freddie Golf Tournament, held this past May. A total of 92 golfers competed in this tournament to raise \$8,360 for the United Way of Greenville County.

ReWa employees also contributed to this success by holding luncheons throughout the summer to raise money. In addition to their luncheons, many employees volunteer as annual givers. 72% of ReWa employees act as Fair Share Givers, donating 1% of their annual salary, or 1 hour per month to the United Way of Greenville County. 27 employees are Palmetto Society Givers, donating \$1,000 or more per year.

ReWa's contribution to the United Way of Greenville County could not have been possible without the generous support of its employees. 97% of them participated in United Way giving programs this year, and look forward to even more prosperous fundraising in the future.
